



2026 Park Construction & Operational Update

Point Grondine Park Management is pleased to share the following construction & operational updates for the 2026 season.

Construction Update

Winter construction is currently underway on **26 new sites**, including:

- **18 drive-in tent sites**
- **8 RV sites (electrical only)**

This winter construction represents the final campground site **development** and is expected to be completed by **June 26, 2026**.

We are hopeful that **final phase construction will begin in Summer of 2026**, which will include development of the **full campground and eco-resort**, including:

- Welcome Centre / Comfort Station
- RV dumping station
- Outdoor Discovery Centre
- Remaining Eco Cabins

During construction, visitors may experience:

- **Periodic closures of Mahiigan Miikan (Lake Access Road)** during May and June

Additional updates will be posted as construction progresses.

Campground Operations

Due to ongoing construction, the campground & Eco Cabin will have a **delayed opening date of June 26, 2026**.

Upon opening, the park will offer the following services for 2026:

- **12 campground sites**
- **8 non-serviced RV sites**
- **1 Eco Cabin**
- **3 campground privies**
- **Lakefront recreational facilities**
- **Day use hiking**
- **Day use canoe rentals**



Additional Amenities

- **Showers and RV pump-out services** are available at **Killarney Provincial Park** with a valid campground permit only.

The **BACKCOUNTRY CAMPING** will be open May 15th, 2026. We will no longer offer backcountry canoe rentals for the 2026 season. Trippers are encouraged to contact Killarney Outfitters for backcountry canoe rentals. Day use rentals are available.
